This document contains information about EDS III Version 3.30 that may not be included in the manual.

What's New in Version 3.30

- An **Update Alphas** button has been added to EDS III's Lettering Dialog Box. When the **Update Alphas** button is clicked, the list of available alphabets is updated. This new push-button will aid users of AutoFont™. Previously, AutoFont users had to restart EDS III before newly installed alphabets could be seen in the alphabet list.
- The Import/Export system has been completely overhauled. Melco.386 is replaced with SYDEXFDD.EXE. The installation program makes the replacement completely automatic.
- EDS III will now recognize the new EMT 1 sewing peripheral.
- The Online manuals have been updated; they have been optimized using the new version of Adobe® Acrobat®. The new version of Adobe Acrobat Reader® (version 3.0) has been included on the diskset. Note: If you have an earlier version of Acrobat reader installed on your computer, ***you must install the new version of Acrobat Reader to view the updated manuals.***

Miscellaneous

If you encounter any of the following situations while using EDS III Version 3.30, refer to this sheet for possible solutions:

Situation: With EDS III running under Microsoft® Windows® 95, click on the taskbar "start" button. Select "Shutdown the Computer," then click "Yes." The system will give a "Fatal Exception Error."

Solution: Close EDS III prior to shutting down Windows 95.

Situation: Under some conditions, when using On-Screen Digitizing with a graphic, the stitches do not line up with the graphics.

Solution: Perform a Zoom-In prior to digitizing a design. Digitizing in the Actual Size view may show some displacement. This is an error in the graphics system only; it will ***not*** be reflected in the embroidery.

Situation: The Online manuals won't open.

Solution: You have not updated your version of Acrobat Reader. The newest version (3.0) is included on your diskset; Run the installer as outlined in the manuals to install the new version of Acrobat Reader. This will enable you to open the Online manuals.
